All courses will provide a certificate of attendance with prompts. If you do not email both the certificate of attendance and the prompts to pandf.feegenerating@jud.state.ma.us by December 15, 2021, your name will automatically be removed from the court-generated Category D list. The subject of the email must be: Category D - Last name.first name.2021CLE. Please do not mail or fax any submissions to the Administrative Office.
