

What is coverage that cares?

At CCA, our health plan is designed around you. We place you with a **personal care coordinator**, who connects you to a wide range of support in your community, including local doctors to help you navigate the healthcare system.

And this personalized, connected care is provided at no cost to you.

Enrollment criteria

1. You're between the ages of 21 and 64.
2. You're entitled to Medicare Part A (hospital insurance), are enrolled in Medicare Part B (medical insurance), and have either MassHealth Standard or MassHealth CommonHealth.
3. You live in one of the following counties: Barnstable, Franklin, Norfolk, Berkshire, Hampden, Plymouth, Bristol, Hampshire, Suffolk, Essex, Middlesex, or Worcester.
