Heywood Hospital in Gardner, MA is a non-profit, acute care community hospital. Opened in 1907, the hospital was given by Mrs. Henry Heywood and her daughter, Helen, in memory of Henry Heywood. Through the years the hospital has undergone many expansions, adding space for maternity care, pediatrics, obstetrics, surgical care, radiology, coronary care, nuclear medicine, and mental health. A medical office building for physician offices and a pharmacy was built in 1990 and expanded in 1996.

Savings Summary

The Need — Improve the lighting quality and reduce operating costs.

The Solution — Installed high-efficient T-8 fluorescent lighting fixtures with occupancy controls. Installed a 250-ton high-efficient, evaporative condensing screw chiller to replace the existing air-cooled chillers and a direct expansion unit serving the medical office building.
