

Project Goals and Objectives

Pedestrians

- Provide adequate sidewalks
- Provide safe crosswalks



Bicyclists

- Provide a westbound connection from Walter to Centre Street
- Reduce high speed turn approaches



Drivers

- Provide adequate lane markings
- Reduce long queues turning into and out of Walter Street from Centre Street





Project Area - Issues

For Pedestrians


- Lack of sidewalks
- Lack of marked crosswalks
- A long walk to the next crosswalk:*
 - ~1/4 mile to VFW Parkway
 - ~1/3 mile to Allandale Street

For Bicyclists

- No westbound connections from Walter to Centre Street
- High speed turn approaches

For Drivers

- No lane markings
- Long queues turning into and out of Walter Street from Centre Street










What we heard from the February Meeting

Concerns


- Long traffic queues
- Lack of access to Arnold Arboretum
- Speeding through the intersection

Requests

- Commenters overwhelmingly disliked the roundabout alternative
- Reconfiguration of bus stops to decrease delays and improve transit rider access to surrounding destinations.
- Increased traffic calming measures
- Shorter crosswalk distances
- Adequate lane markings and street signals
- Increased bike safety




Street View - Centre Street Northbound






Street View - Centre Street Southbound

Winter-Spring 2020 Collect data, raise awareness, and gather public input.



Spring-Summer 2020

Gather comments, select preferred alternative, update & discuss with stakeholders, and start design.



Summer 2020-

Winter 2021

Continue design through summer and fall. Wrap up by winter.



Winter -Spring 2021

Award project and begin construction.
