¹ The Chair anticipate that at other times on January 6, 2023, the CERB will deliberate for the purpose of making decisions required in adjudicatory proceedings brought before it. Pursuant to M.G.L. c. 30A, §18 (d), meetings of quasi-judicial boards held for the sole purpose of adjudicative deliberations are excluded from the definition of meetings subject to the Open Meeting Law, M. G. L. c. 30A, §§18-25. Accordingly, these deliberations are not open to the public or

subject to any other requirements set forth in the Open Meeting Law.

² The CERB will not reconvene in open session at the end of the Executive Session.
