## CLEAN ENERGY TRANSMISSION WORKING GROUP and GRID MODERNIZATION ADVISORY COUNCIL

In July 2022, the Massachusetts State Legislature passed An Act Driving Clean Energy and Offshore Wind, St. 2002, c. 179 ("Act"), which requires the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") to convene a stakeholder working group to provide a comprehensive cost analysis of major transmission infrastructure upgrades that may be needed to deliver clean energy generation procured pursuant to the laws of the Commonwealth for the use of residents of the Commonwealth and the region, and develop and approve a final report, along with any recommendations for legislative and regulatory actions at the state, regional, and federal level. The Act designated a seventeen-member working group. As a multi-member committee established to serve a public purpose, the Clean Energy Transmission Working Group (CETWG) is subject to open meeting law.
