Subject: Change to CFDA Number for Dislocated Worker Appropriations

Purpose: To alert grant recipients that the CFDA number 17.260 will no longer be used in fiscal year 2011 for grants associated with the WIA Dislocated Worker appropriation. This includes WIA Title I Dislocated Worker funds, WIA National Emergency Grants, WIA Dislocated Worker National Reserve Demonstration Grants, and WIA Dislocated Worker National Reserve Technical Assistance and Training Grants.

Background: OMB Circular A-133 requires grantees to identify all Federal awards by the CFDA title and number, award number and year, name of the pass-through agency, and name of the federal agency. This information will be used by the auditors to prepare the Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards in the Single Audit.

Action

Required: Beginning with grants issued after June 30, 2010, local area fiscal agents should ensure that the information given to their auditors reflects the appropriate change to the CFDA numbers for all grants issued from the WIA Dislocated Worker appropriation after June 30, 2010. For all such grants, the following CFDA numbers will be used:

17.277 WIA National Emergency Grants (NEG)
17.278 WIA Dislocated Worker Formula Grants

17.280 WIA Dislocated Worker National Reserve Demonstration Grants
17.281 WIA Dislocated Worker National Reserve Technical Assistance &
Training

Grants awarded prior to July 1, 2010 will continue to use CFDA number 17.260 during the life of their funds; therefore, no modifications of existing grants will be necessary.
