The following aggregate data on the issuance of firearm licenses and cards pursuant to sections 129B, 131 and 131F:	Published Location
(i) the age, gender, race, ethnicity and municipality of applicants for a license to carry;	Firearm License Applicants - Demographic Data <i>Please note: Data on race and ethnicity is not currently available but will be collected through the Massachusetts Instant Record Check System (MIRCS) starting in October 2025. EOPSS will update this dashboard in 2026 to reflect the newly collected race and ethnicity data.</i>
(ii) the age, gender, race, ethnicity and municipality of individuals whose applications for a license to carry were denied;	
(iii) the age, gender, race, ethnicity and municipality of applicants for a firearm identification card; and	
(iv) the age, gender, race, ethnicity and municipality of individuals whose applications for a firearm identification card were denied.	
The following aggregate data on firearm-involved violence, including, but not limited to, firearm-involved crimes and attempted or completed suicides using firearms:	Published Location
(i) the type of firearm-involved violence, for example, attempted or completed suicide, homicide, accidental shooting, or other firearm-involved crime;	Victim Demographics in Incidents Involving Firearms
(iv) the geographic location of the firearm-involved violence;	Firearm Incidents - Offender Demographic Data

(ii) the age, gender, race and ethnicity of the firearm user;	Firearm Incidents - Offender Demographic Data
(iii) the age, gender, race and ethnicity of any victims of firearm-involved violence;	Victim Demographics in Incidents Involving Firearms
(viii) the disposition of any prosecution;	Firearm Incidents - Disposition Information by Offense Severity

(ix) whether the firearm was used in connection with known gang activity, domestic dispute or police interaction;	Planned Enhancements
(x) the make, model, manufacturer and state or country of origin of the involved firearm;	
(v) the status of the license of the firearm user;	
(vi) whether the firearm user, at the time of the incident, would be considered a prohibited person as described in section 121F;	
(vii) whether the firearm user was arrested as a result of the incident;	
(xi) the origin, source and secondary market of the involved firearm, including whether it was purchased from a licensed dealer or private seller;	
(xii) whether the involved firearm was lost, stolen or otherwise illegally obtained; and	
(xiii) whether the involved firearm was untraceable or a privately made firearm, including the manner in which it was produced.
