Information and Procedures for Reporting a Suspected Violation

- •Date/time of documented suspected instances of non-compliance
- •Photos
- Names of site personnel
- •DEP staff will contact the Licensee/operator, conduct a site inspection, review licensing documents
- •DEP staff do not follow up with a reporting party requests for status of review, determination, resolution must be sent to DEP
- •Certain enforcement-sensitive information, documents and communications may not be available as public records
