VOLUNTARY SURRENDER AGREEMENT

The Board of Registration in Pharmacy ("Board") and Charles E. Sliwoski, Jr. ("Registrant"), a pharmacist registered by the Board (Pharmacist Registration No. 18064), do hereby stipulate and agree that the following information shall be entered into and become a permanent part of the file of Registrant that is maintained by the Board:

- 1. The Registrant hereby acknowledges that, while employed as a pharmacist at Partners Pharmacy ("the pharmacy") in Marlborough, Mass., during the period January, 2008 through June, 2008, the Registrant diverted controlled substances from the pharmacy for personal use or gain, including Dexedrine and amphetamine, on various dates.
- 2. The Registrant, having previously relinquished physical custody of his pharmacist's license to the Board, hereby voluntarily SURRENDERS his right and authorization to practice as a pharmacist in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts (License No. 18064). The Registrant acknowledges and agrees that the surrender period shall be for a minimum of five years, as set forth in paragraph three (3) of this Agreement.
- 3 The Registrant offers this surrender of his pharmacist license with the understanding that the surrender period shall be for a minimum five (5) year period and shall continue until the Board, in its discretion, determines that the Registrant is eligible to petition for the reinstatement of his license. The Board and the Registrant agree that the Board will not review and the Registrant may not file any petition for relicensure with the Board during the five (5) year period following the date of execution of this Voluntary Surrender Agreement ("Agreement") by the Registrant. At the time of any such petition for licensure as a pharmacist, the Board may consider any criminal convictions or relevant conduct not referenced in paragraph one of this Agreement. At this time, the Board envisions no conditions pursuant to which Registrant would qualify for relicensure as a pharmacist in the Commonwealth in the future. However, if at any time in the future Registrant seeks relicensure by the Board, the Board may require the Registrant to complete certain requirements and meet specific terms and conditions for relicensure prior to filing any petition for relicensure, including but not limited to, successful completion of the Massachusetts Professional Recovery System (MPRS) Program for a minimum five (5) year period and re-examination, and may require and impose monitoring and practice limitation conditions on his license, including but not limited to,

probationary status and MPRS participation. The Registrant acknowledges that he will be required to meet any and all statutory and/or regulatory licensure requirements in effect at the time of any petition for licensure.

- 4. This Agreement and its contents shall be incorporated into the records maintained by the Board. This Agreement is a public record subject to disclosure to the public and equivalent state licensing boards.
- 5. The Board agrees that in return for Registrant's execution of this Agreement, the Board will not advance the prosecution of the complaint docket no. 20080718-PH-012. Any and all other rights of the Board to take action within the scope of its authority are expressly reserved.
- The Registrant understands and agrees that the decision to enter into this Agreement and 6. to accept the terms and conditions herein described is a final act and is not subject to reconsideration or judicial review.
- The Registrant states that he has used legal counsel in connection with his decision to 7. enter into this Agreement.
- 8. The Registrant certifies that he has read this document entitled "Voluntary Surrender Agreement." The Registrant understands that, by executing this Agreement, he is waiving his right to a formal hearing concerning complaint docket no. 20080718-PH-012, at which he would possess the rights to confront and cross-examine witnesses, to call witnesses, to present evidence, to testify on his own behalf, to contest the allegations, to present oral argument, to appeal to court in the event of an adverse ruling, and all other rights set forth in G.L. c. 30A and 801 CMR 1.01 et seq. Registrant states that he further understands that in executing this document entitled "Voluntary Surrender Agreement", he is knowingly and voluntarily waiving his right to a formal hearing and to all of the above listed rights.
