REPORT OF THE TOWN OF CHARLTON ON THE REQUEST FOR AMENDMENTS TO THE TOWN OF CHARLTON CABLE TELEVISION RENEWAL LICENSE

Amendment #1:

Section 2.2---TERM OF RENEWAL LICENSE

+ Description of proposed Amendment:

Section 2.2 has been amended to reflect the fact that the Town of Charlton (the "Town") and Charter have agreed to extend the term of the Renewal License until June 28, 2019.

+ Text of amended Section 2.2: The Renewal License is hereby amended by deleting the section in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

The term of this Renewal License shall commence on June 29, 2009 and shall expire on June 28, 2019, unless sooner terminated as provided herein.

+ Purpose for which the Amendment is being made:

The Town and Charter have agreed to extend the current Renewal License term to allow Charter to continue operating in the Town in accordance with the terms and conditions in these amendments.

+ Date Amendment Received by the Issuing Authority and the Licensee:

March 26, 2014

+ Probable Effects on Cable Television Subscribers and other Concerned Parties:

Subscribers and other concerned parties in Charlton will benefit from continued Cable Service(s) provided by Charter.

Amendment #2:

Section 6.6--- SUPPORT PAYMENTS FOR PEG ACCESS

+ Description of proposed Amendment:

Section 6.6(a) has been amended to reflect the fact that Charter has agreed to continue to provide annual funding for PEG Access Programming for the extended term of the Renewal License, through June 28, 2019.

+ Text of amended Section 6.6(a): The Renewal License is hereby amended by deleting the section in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

Commencing on the first anniversary of the Effective Date of this Renewal License through the expiration of this Renewal License, as amended, the Licensee shall make an annual PEG Access support payment to the Issuing Authority, or to the Access Provider if so designated in writing by the Issuing Authority, in the amount of Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000.00). For the extended five (5) year Renewal License term, the Licensee shall make said annual \$90,000.00 payments no later than the following:

2014: Within sixty (60) days of the Renewal License Amendment;

2015: No later than June 29, 2015;

2016: No later than June 29, 2016;

2017: No later than June 29, 2017; and

2018: No later than June 29, 2018.

Said annual payments shall be used for, among other things, salary, staffing, equipment, operating and other related expenses connected with PEG Access Programming and operations. The amount of the annual PEG Support payments shall be an external cost and may be charged to Charlton Subscribers.

+ Purpose for which the Amendment is being made:

Charter has agreed to continue to provide annual funding for PEG Access Programming purposes.

+ Date Amendment Received by the Issuing Authority and the Licensee:

March 26, 2014

+ Probable Effects on Cable Television Subscribers and other Concerned Parties:

Subscribers and other concerned parties in Charlton will benefit from the continuing funding for PEG Access Programming purposes.

Amendment #3:

Section 6.7--- PEG ACCESS EQUIPMENT/FACILITIES FUNDING

+ Description of proposed Amendment:

Charter has agreed to make an additional payment to the Issuing Authority in the amount of One Hundred and Five Thousand Dollars (\$105,000.00) during the extended Renewal license term for PEG Access equipment-facilities purposes, payable within sixty (60) days of the Effective Date of this Renewal License Amendment.

+ Text of amended Section 6.7(a): The Renewal License is hereby amended by deleting the current language and replacing it with the following:

Within sixty (60) days of the Effective Date of this Renewal License, the Licensee shall provide a one-time cash payment to the Issuing Authority, or to the Access Provider if so designated in writing by the Issuing Authority, in the amount of One Hundred and Five Thousand Dollars (\$105,000.00) for equipment and facilities. Within sixty (60) days of the Effective Date of the Renewal License Amendment, the Licensee shall provide an additional cash payment to the Issuing Authority, or to the Access Provider if so designated in writing by the Issuing Authority, in the amount of One Hundred and Five Thousand Dollars (\$105,000.00) for equipment and facilities. Said funding and/or equipment and facilities shall be used for cable-related expenses such as PEG Access equipment, supplies, operating costs and/or other costs related to data transmission operating fees and equipment. The amount of this funding shall be an external cost and may be charged to Charlton Subscribers. All PEG access equipment and/or facilities shall be owned by the Town, unless otherwise noted.

+ Purpose for which the Amendment is being made:

Charter has agreed to provide additional funding for PEG Access equipment-facilities purposes.
