NOTICE OF SUSPENSION

August 11, 2025

After a hearing on July 22, 2025, the Commission finds Super Food Mart Inc d/b/a Charlton Food Mart violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. The Commission **SUSPENDS the license for a period of one (1) day.**

By decision dated September 4, 2024, the Commission ordered a one (1) day license suspension to be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations were found by this Commission. Based on the violation found above, the licensee violated the conditions of that one (1) day suspension being held in abeyance. The Commission hereby orders that suspension to be served on and after the 1-day suspension. The Licensee will serve a total of two (2) days.

The suspension shall commence on Monday, September 29, 2025, and terminate on Tuesday, September 30, 2025. The license will be delivered to the Local Licensing Board or its designee on Monday, September 29, 2025, at 9:00 A.M. It will be returned to the licensee on October 1, 2025.

You are advised that pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L. c. 138 § 23, you may petition the Commission to accept an offer in compromise in lieu of suspension within twenty (20) calendar days following such notice of such suspension. If accepted, you may pay a fine using the enclosed form which must be signed by the Licensee and a Massachusetts Licensed Accountant.

You are advised that you have the right to appeal this decision under M.G.L. c. 30A to Superior Court within thirty (30) days upon receipt of this notice.

DECISION

Super Food Mart Inc d/b/a Charlton Food Mart (“Licensee”) holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (“Commission” or “ABCC”) held a hearing on Tuesday, July 22, 2025, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigators David and Temple’s Minimum Purchase Age Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigators David and Temple’s Minimum Purchase Age Compliance Check Field Report, 5/6/25;
2. ABCC Form 43, Transfer of License Approval, 10/06/2005;
3. ABCC Decision, 8/29/2022;
4. ABCC Decision, 9/4/2024;
5. Licensee’s Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On Tuesday, May 6, 2025, at approximately 7:15 p.m., Investigators David and Temple (“Investigators”) conducted a compliance check at Super Food Mart Inc d/b/a Charlton Food Mart.
2. An underage operative, working under the supervision of Investigators, purchased an alcoholic beverage, one White Claw Blood Orange for three dollars and forty-nine cents (\$3.49). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
3. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 15 since 2005 with two prior violations.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. Therefore, the Commission **SUSPENDS the license for a period of one (1) day.**

By decision dated September 4, 2024, the Commission ordered a one (1) day license suspension to be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations were found by this Commission.
