### **DECISION**

SUPER FOOD MART INC. D/B/A CHARLTON FOOD MART 109 MASONIC HOME ROAD CHARLTON, MA 01507 LICENSE#: 00032-PK-0190

VIOLATION DATE: 5/29/2024

HEARD: 9/03/2024

Super Food Mart Inc. d/b/a Charlton Food Mart ("Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("ABCC" or "Commission") held a remote hearing via Microsoft Teams on Tuesday, September 3, 2024, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigators Kujawski & Gould's Minimum Purchase Age Compliance Check Field Report.

### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On Wednesday, May 29, 2024, at approximately 5:41 p.m., Investigators Kujawski and Gould ("Investigators"), conducted a compliance check at Super Food Mart Inc. d/b/a Charlton Food Mart.
- 2. An underage operative working under the supervision of Investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, one 25-ounce Natural Ice beer, for one dollar (\$1.00). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
- 3. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 15 since 2005 with one previous violation.

# CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. As a result, the Commission suspends the license for a period of one (1) day which will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission regulations are found by this Commission.
