PIC Change Charge

The PIC Charge is billed to the Telephone Company's End User as stated in the Telephone Company's Local and Intrastate Interexchange Tariff M.D.T.E Tariff No. 3. If the Customer elects to pay this charge for the End User, the Customer will arrange such credit or payment directly with the Telephone Company's End User.

A charge to the Customer will apply when an unauthorized PIC change occurs and the Customer cannot provide appropriate documentation authorizing such change. The charge will be applied as follows:

If a Telephone Number is not found, a per/Telephone Number-Not Found charge is still applicable.
