DECISION

**CBI OPERATIONS LLC D/B/A CHATHAM BARS INN

CBI Operations LLC d/b/a Chatham Bars Inn (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, November 21, 2017, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Binienda's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Binienda's Compliance Check Field Report; and
2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

The Commission took Administrative Notice of the Licensee's record.

FACTS

1. On Wednesday, July 19, 2017, at approximately 6:50 p.m., Investigators Velez and Binienda ("Investigators") investigated the business CBI Operations LLC d/b/a Chatham Bars Inn.
2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, was served by the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a Bud Light beer. The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION


Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. As the Licensee has been in business for more than 10 years with no prior violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
