

## Check a license


You do not need a MyMassGov account to check a license.

- 1) To look up a license or permit, click next to the **To search for a license** prompt on DOL's Home page:

- 3) At the top of the form, click a tab to search for a person's license or a business' license.
- 4) Enter information that eLIPSE should search for.
- 5) At the bottom right of the form, click the **Search** button.
- 6) eLIPSE will display a list of licenses that match what you entered. To view a license in detail, at the right side of its row, click the **View License** button.

### Tips for searching

- You don't need to fill in every part of the form. For example, you do not need to know a license number to locate a license. Enter as much as you know.
- Spell what you enter correctly. If you misspell a person's name or their city, eLIPSE will not be able to find them.
- If you filled in a lot of the form and eLIPSE cannot locate the license, try using less information.
