**DECISION**

**CARIBBEAN LIQUORS, INC DBA CARIBBEAN LIQUOR INC.**  
**399 BROADWAY**  
**CHELSEA, MA 02150**

Caribbean Liquors, Inc. dba Caribbean Liquor, Inc. (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, November 29, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Michael Teehan's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
2. Compliance Check Field Report dated July 6, 2011.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

**FACTS**

1. On July 6, 2011 at approximately 5:44 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Caribbean Liquors, Inc. dba Caribbean Liquor, Inc.
2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a King Cobra forty (40) ounce can for two dollars (\$2.00). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

**CONCLUSION**

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34. The Commission **suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**
