## **DECISION**

FINE MART LLC 266 BROADWAY CHELSEA, MA 02150 LICENSE#: 020200054 HEARD: 10/4/2011

Fine Mart, LLC (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("the General Laws chapter 138, §12. Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, October 4, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Michael Teehan's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and

2. Compliance Check Field Report of Investigator Michael Teehan.

## **FACTS**

- 1. On, July 6, 2011 at approximately 5:54 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Fine Mart, LLC.
- 2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a six (6) pack of Bud Light bottles for seven dollars and seventy five cents (\$7.75). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

## CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
