NOTICE OF SUSPENSION

After a hearing on October 16, 2012, the Commission finds Akshar Ji Corp. dba Cheshire Liquor Center in violation of 204 CMR 2.05(2) - Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c.138, §34 – Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under 21 years of age.

The Commission suspends the licensee's license for a total of five (5) days to be served. The suspension shall commence on Wednesday, December 5, 2012 and terminate on Sunday, December 9, 2012. The license will be delivered to the Local Licensing Board or its designee on Wednesday, December 5, 2012 at 9:00 A.M. It will be returned to the licensee Monday, December 10, 2012.

You are advised that pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L. c.138 §23, you may petition the Commission to accept an offer in compromise in lieu of suspension within twenty (20) calendar days following such notice of such suspension. If accepted, you may pay a fine using the enclosed form. All checks must be certified and accompanied by the enclosed form, which must be signed by a Massachusetts Licensed Accountant.

You are advised that you have the right to appeal this decision under M.G.L. c. 30A to Superior Court within thirty (30) days upon receipt of this notice.

DECISION

AKSHAR JI CORP. DBA CHESHIRE LIQUOR CENTER 104 ROUTE 8 SOUTH STREET CHESHIRE, MA 01225 LICENSE#: 021000010 HEARD: 10/16/2012

Akshar Ji Corp. dba Cheshire Liquor Center (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, October 16, 2012, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05(2) - Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c.138, §34 – Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under 21 years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Keefe's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigator Keefe's Compliance Check Field Report dated May 23, 2012;
- 2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
- 3. Licensee's Memorandum in Support of Request for Suspended Sentence.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FACTS

- 1. On Wednesday, May 23, 2012 , at approximately 8:52 p.m., Investigators Kujawski and Keefe conducted an investigation of the business operation of Akshar Ji Corp. dba Cheshire Liquor Center.
- 2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a can of Bud Light beer, for two dollars and fifty-five cents (\$2.55). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05(2) - Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c.138, §34 – Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under 21 years of age. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for seven (7) days of which five (5) days will be served and two (2) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
