DECISION

PALLAM OF CHICOPEE INC. DBA MY BROTHER'S PLACE
185 GROVE ST
CHICOPEE, MA 01020
LICENSE#: 022000042

Pallam of Chicopee Inc. dba My Brother's Place (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, July 22, 2014, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) - Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138, §34 Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Kujawski's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
2. Investigator Kujawski's Compliance Check Field Report dated April 14, 2014.

FACTS


1. On Monday, April 14, 2014, at approximately 6:32 p.m., Investigators Keefe and Kujawski conducted an investigation of the business operation of Pallam of Chicopee Inc. dba My Brother's Place.
2. An underage operative, working with investigators, purchased an alcoholic beverage, a container of Budweiser Light beer for three dollars (\$3.00). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION


Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) - Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138, §34 - Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. As the licensee has been in business for more than thirty-eight (38) years with no previous violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
