Transportation Services – Contractor shall execute an agreement with Transportation Service Providers to provide Transportation to and from the Vaccination Service Site. Through its agreements with Transportation Service Providers, Contractor shall assure access to Transportation Services for individuals with disabilities, including any necessary modifications required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. Contractor shall limit use of Transportation Services to those individuals who meet DPH eligibility criteria to receive these services, including self-attested income eligibility, allowed ride distance, allowed ride start/end points, and any other criteria established by DPH in writing. For the avoidance of doubt, DPH shall reimburse Contractor for rides based on the criteria in effect when a ride was ordered. Contractor shall order Transportation Services for eligible individuals through Contractor's call center.

DPH shall reimburse Contractor for the actual cost of these Transportation Services, as evidenced by invoices provided by Transportation Service Providers. Maximum approved costs associated with Transportation Program Integrity & Billing Management are specified in the table above. DPH shall not reimburse Contractor for any Transportation Services costs or related administrative costs or fees except as described in this paragraph and reflected in the table above.

For each week, the maximum weekly amount shall be the amount set forth above for the respective week; provided, however, that to the extent the actual number of vaccinations in such week is more than the number of vaccination set forth above ("Weekly Vaccine Amount"), the applicable maximum weekly amount shall be calculated by multiplying the number of vaccines in excess of

the Weekly Vaccine Amount by \$23.29 and adding that amount to the applicable amount set for above for the respective week. For example, if 20,000 vaccinations are performed during the week ending 3/28/21, the maximum weekly amount shall be: \$407,641 plus ((20,000 - 17,500) multiplied by \$23.29)) = \$465,875.

Estimated Approved Costs for Additional other Authorized Sites may be added by amending this Exhibit and with the mutual agreement of DPH and the Contractor.

The parties agree that the pricing specified above in **Exhibit B** for each Authorized Site shall be subject to renegotiation six weeks after the start date of that Authorized Site, with best faith efforts to lower costs. Prior to any renegotiation, contractor shall provide DPH a report of the actual costs incurred in operating the Authorized Site over the preceding six weeks.

The guaranteed minimum weekly payments at 1350 Tremont St, Boston, MA 02120 shall be:

*Actual expenses from February 25th – March 21st will be direct pass throughs

The guaranteed minimum weekly payments from DPH to the Contractor may be adjusted either up or down with mutual agreement and written confirmation from DPH to the Contractor.

Guaranteed minimum weekly payments may be established for other Authorized Sites by amending this Exhibit and with the mutual agreement of DPH and the Contractor.

For the initial six (6) weeks that each Authorized Site is operational under this Contract, the Vaccination Administration Payment shall be equal to the Vaccination Administration Payment Rate multiplied by the higher of: (a) that actual number of vaccines administered for Vaccination Services at the Authorized Site; or (b) scheduled minimum Vaccination Capacity and Vaccination Administration Payment as set forth above.

The Contractor must open a number of vaccination appointments at each Authorized Site that exceeds the scheduled minimum Vaccination Capacity, as specified above. If the Contractor fails to offer the minimum number of appointments required, the minimum Vaccination Administration Capacity and Vaccination Administration Payment set forth above shall be void and the Contractor shall be paid only for the Vaccination Administration Payment multiplied by the actual number of vaccines administered for Vaccination Services at the Authorized Site.

Notwithstanding the above, DPH reserves the right to adjust the minimum Vaccination Administration Capacity and Vaccination Administration Payments set forth above. DPH will provide 14 days' notice of changes which result in maintaining current levels of capacity and 28 days' notice of changes which result in decreasing current capacity.
