## **Contest Themes:**

- Honoring the contributions and achievements of women in U.S. politics and/or in civic life
- The right to vote: past, present and future
- The story of the 19th Amendment/ remembering the sacrifices made on behalf of suffrage
- The importance of responsible and active citizenship/recognizing the power of one's vote

### **Contest Rules:**

- Applicant must be a Massachusetts high school student
- Material must be original work of the applicant
- Submission may be in any of these categories:
  - A 400-600 word **essay** submitted electronically; or
  - o A digital video no more than 3 minutes in length submitted via a link to YouTube; or
  - A **poster** no larger than 22" x 28" in dimension submitted electronically via Flickr
- Applicants may submit one entry per media category essay, video and/or poster
- Applicants must provide registration form with original parent/guardian signature
- Submissions will be judged by the following criteria: (1) clarity, persuasiveness and/or significance of communicating topic or theme, (2) creative use of chosen media, (3) presentation, and (4) originality of ideas

## Prizes to be Awarded – in Essay, Digital Video and Poster categories:

- Three **\$200 U.S. Savings Bonds** awarded for winning 1<sup>st</sup> place entries in each category
- Three **\$100 U.S. Savings Bonds** awarded for winning 2<sup>nd</sup> place entries in each category
- Three **\$50 U.S. Savings Bonds** awarded for winning 3<sup>rd</sup> place entries in each category

### **Directions for How to Apply:**

- **Essays** should be sent via email to <u>agoweb@state.ma.us</u> no later than December 10, 2010. Please include applicant's contact information (name, address, and phone number) in the email and note "Essay Contest" in the subject line. In addition, the essay should be printed out and mailed, along with a completed registration form (postmarked no later than December 10, 2010) to the address listed on the form.
- **Digital videos** should be posted on YouTube by the applicant and then the link to the video and the applicant's contact information (name, address, and phone number) should be emailed (note "Video Contest" in the subject line) to agoweb@state.ma.us no later than December 10, 2010. In addition, the contest registration form must be completed and mailed (postmarked no later than December 10, 2010), to the address listed on the form. *Note: a selection of finalists in the video category may be asked to provide a copy of their video in CD/DVD format to the address listed on the form.*
- A digital photo of the **poster** should be posted on Flickr by the applicant and then a link to the photo should be sent via email (note "Poster Contest" in the subject line) to <a href="mailto:agoweb@state.ma.us">agoweb@state.ma.us</a> no later than December 10, 2010. The email must also include the applicant's contact information: name, address, and phone number. In addition, the contest registration form must be completed and mailed (postmarked no later than December 10, 2010), to the address listed on the form. Note: a selection of finalists in the poster category may be asked to mail in their poster to the address listed on the form.
