The Commonwealth of Massachusetts' Division of Capital Asset Management and Maintenance hereby gives notice that, pursuant to Section 37 of Chapter 7C of the Massachusetts General Laws, a public hearing will be conducted to disclose the conditions and reasons for the proposed purchase of 8.5± acres of real property located at 89 Mount Wayte Avenue, at the intersection of Franklin Street in Framingham, Massachusetts, (the "Property").

The Property is owned by the Massachusetts State College Building Authority and is currently used for parking and storage by Framingham State University ("FSU"). The proposed new use will add a new Health Sciences Center for Massachusetts Bay Community College ("MBCC") with accessory parking to the existing uses by FSU. Both uses will coexist on the Property. The Commonwealth has determined that the Property is essential for the replacement of existing MBCC health science facilities currently located in Framingham.
