If you test positive for Hep C, we can help you get treated!

Please bring these things to your appointment:



A list of all your medications, including herbal/natural and over-the-counter products.



A photo ID, health insurance & prescription cards (if you have them).

If you don't have these, we will help you get them!

What to expect during your appointment:



Staff will ask you questions about your medical history.



Staff will draw your blood to help make a plan for your treatment.



You will have the opportunity to ask questions.



You will be prescribed your medication once we get your lab results back.



We will call you to check in on how your treatment is going!

Treatment will take **8-12 weeks** and involves taking **daily pills**. As part of treatment, you may have more appointments or more labs.
