## **Clinch Knots**

Before you catch a fish, your hook or lure needs to be attached to your line with a knot. A **clinch knot** is one of the most common fishing knots, and a good way to secure a hook, lure, or swivel to the line.

## How to tie a clinch knot

- Thread the end of the line through the eye of the hook, swivel, or lure. Double back and make five or more turns around the standing line (watch video below).
- 2. Bring the end of the line through the first loop formed behind the eye, then through the big loop.
- 3. Wet the knot and gently pull on the tag end to start drawing the coils together. Pull on the standing line to form knot with coils.
- Slide the coil tight against the eye and cut the tag end.
