## DECISION

THE OLD TIMER INC **155 CHURCH STREET -167** CLINTON, MA 01510 LICENSE#: 023400005 HEARD: 10/25/2011

The Old Timer Inc. (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws chapter 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, October 25, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Brad Doyle's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
- 2. Compliance Check Field Report of Investigator Brad Doyle.

There is one (1) tape of this hearing.

## FACTS

1. On, August 3, 2011 at approximately 7:53 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation The Old Timer Inc.

- 2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased an alcoholic beverage for three dollars and zero cents (\$3.00). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
- 3. Administrative review of the file indicates that the licensee has no prior violations.

## CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
