Wai-Hon Inc. dba Fung Wong Restaurant (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, July 23, 2013, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an Illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138 §34 Sale or Delivery of an Alcoholic Beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Bailey's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 2. Investigator Bailey's Compliance Check Field Report dated April 11, 2013;

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FACTS

- 1. On Thursday, April 11, 2013, at approximately 6:30 p.m., Investigators Doyle and Bailey conducted an investigation of the business operation of Wai-Hon Inc. dba Fung Wong Restaurant.
- 2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a bottle of Budweiser Light beer, for three dollars and seventy-five cents (\$3.75). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an Illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138 §34 Sale or Delivery of an Alcoholic Beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. As the licensee has been in business for over ten (10) years and has had no previous violations, the Commission issues a WARNING.
