

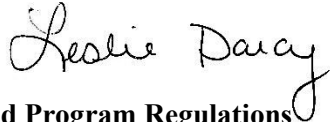

Transmittal Letter COH-15

TO: Chronic Disease and Rehabilitation Hospitals Participating in MassHealth

RE: *Chronic Disease and Rehabilitation Hospital Manual: Revised Program Regulations*

This letter transmits revisions to the Outpatient Hospital Services regulations at 130 CMR 410.000. MassHealth is making these revisions in connection with amendments to the Community Health Center regulations at 130 CMR 405.000 and the Pharmacy Services regulations at 130 CMR 406.000. Changes are summarized below; please review the referenced documents to see all changes.

The amendments end MassHealth pharmacy coverage for drugs acquired through the 340B Drug Pricing Program (“340B drugs”) billed through pharmacy point-of-sale adjudication. Members will continue to have full access to drugs when not acquired through the 340B Drug Pricing Program. Coverage will remain for most 340B drugs administered by clinicians. The proposed changes also remove requirements that a clinician-administered drug be high cost before it is carved out from MassHealth coverage for drugs acquired through the 340B Drug Pricing Program.

These amendments are effective July 3, 2026.
