UNIFORM GUIDELINES FOR INSPECTION/CLEANING REPORTS

The purpose of this document is to provide for <u>minimum</u> guidelines for deficiency reports. Forms that contain more information are acceptable for use in the Commonwealth. The purpose of this form is to establish a minimum set of information to be provided to the Head of the Local Fire Department, as required under 527 CMR 1.00:50.5.6.14.1.1.

The information below identifies the minimum requirements established by the State Fire Marshal.
