
## Sign-Off on Sep 22<sup>nd</sup> and Nov 6<sup>th</sup> Commission Meeting Minutes

# Summary of Feedback from Secretaries



- Secretary Jones added additional information on the ongoing work by EOLWD, Commonwealth Corporation, and MassCEC to leverage funds provided through the Commonwealth Corporation (such as CTI, WCTF) to create additional training pathways into clean energy trades
- Secretary Jones also called out the importance of collaborating with organizations like Massachusetts Girls in Trades to spark interest in the building trades and apprenticeship opportunities among young women, who have been historically underrepresented in these jobs
- Secretary Tepper had no direct comments/edits on the report
