Ratification of the Chairman's Fifth Set of Orders

RE: Ratification of the Chairman's Fifth Set of Orders under G.L. c. 25, § 4B

Dear All,

This follows up on Chairman Angela O'Connor's letter of November 30, 2018, in which she issued her Fifth Set of Orders pursuant to section 4B of chapter 25 of the General Laws and the authority granted to her by Governor Baker thereunder. That letter, which is attached, ordered investor-owned gas distribution companies (the "Gas Companies") regulated by the Department of Public Utilities (the "Department") to pay for and cooperate with an independent statewide examination of the safety of the Commonwealth's gas distribution system being conducted by a third-party evaluator.

To assure public safety and the continuing availability of gas, the Department has signed a contract with Dynamic Risk, effective November 14, 2018, to conduct this independent statewide examination. The examination will assess (1) the physical integrity and safety of the Commonwealth's gas distribution system and (2) the operation and maintenance policies and practices of the Gas Companies and municipal gas companies, with respect to the Commonwealth's gas distribution system. Dynamic Risk will issue a report that will include, but not be limited to, potential opportunities for improvement in each of these areas.

Under the powers granted to Chairman O'Connor by Governor Baker and pursuant to section 4B of chapter 25 of the General Laws, the Department's Commission hereby ratifies the Chairman's Fifth Set of Orders. Under this ratification, the Chairman's Fifth Set of Orders shall be effective until and including December 31, 2019.

If any of the Gas Companies fail to carry out the Chairman's Fifth Set of Orders during this time period, it will be assessed penalties up to \$1,000,000 per violation.
