### **REQUEST FOR LEAVE TO OBTAIN DIRECT APPELLATE REVIEW**

Pursuant to Rule 11 of the Massachusetts Rules of Appellate Procedure, defendant-appellant Che Meranda respectfully applies for direct appellate review of his conviction. After traffic cameras captured his family being targeted in a drive-by shooting while stopped at an intersection, Meranda was convicted on multiple counts of assault to kill and other charges for shooting back at his attackers despite no damage to them or the other car and no one even placing a gun in his hand, much less observing any shots. The Commonwealth argued that three pieces of circumstantial evidence, when considered together, could nonetheless support his conviction beyond a reasonable doubt: the presence of gunshot residue and bullet casings in his car after the family abandoned it, his passenger's testimony that after they were shot at when leaving the car, she saw what looked like a handgun sitting on the dashboard, and the traffic cameras showing that after the car shooting at them first passed Meranda turned in the same direction it had gone. Because even in combination the Commonwealth's evidence could do no more than plausibly theorize the criminal acts upon which it grounded Meranda's convictions, they must all be reversed and the charges against him dismissed. Because the sufficiency of the evidence issues raised are best served through resolution by the full Court, he respectfully requests direct appellate review.

### **STATEMENT OF PRIOR PROCEEDINGS**

On October 1, 2021 Meranda was indicted on three charges of armed assault to murder, G.L. c. 265 §18(b), two armed career criminal charges under G.L. c. 269 §10(g), carrying a loaded firearm without a license, G.L. c. 269 §10(n), possession of ammunition without a license, G.L. c. 269 §10(h)(1), two counts of reckless endangerment of a child, G.L. c. 269 §13L, and discharge of a firearm within 500 feet of a building, G.L. c. 269 §12E. After a jury trial held over 7 days in April of 2023 (Kazanjian, J.), he was found guilty of two counts of the lesser included charge of assault to kill (G.L. c. 265 §18N) and one count of the lesser included charge of assault with a dangerous weapon (G.L. c. 265 §15B) on the three assault to murder charges, with guilty verdicts on the remainder. The judge found him guilty of one armed career criminal charge in a bench trial, while a *nolle prosequi* was entered on the other, and on the ammunition charge. On May 4, 2023, he was sentenced to seven years imprisonment on count 1, followed consecutively by concurrent three-year sentences on counts 2, 3, and 4, in turn followed consecutively by (concurrent) six- and three-month sentences on counts 5 and 9, and then finally released to concurrent probation terms of three years each on counts 3, 7, and 8. A timely notice of appeal was filed. His case was entered in the Appeals Court as 2025-P-0601 on May 19, 2025, after a lengthy delay in transcript preparation.

## **STATEMENT OF FACTS**

A traffic camera showed Meranda's car being fired upon as he waited at a T-intersection and then pausing for a moment before turning right, in the same direction the other car had gone. A second camera a short distance away showed the two cars speeding past. Both were abandoned separately a few blocks southeast: Meranda's car that his girlfriend had rented three days earlier in Florida was pockmarked with bullet holes and had a broken passenger side window and a shell casing wedged in its roof rack, with four others on the passenger side seat and in the footwell, while the other car was unmarked. His girlfriend testified to hearing loud sounds of shooting while crouched forward and covering her head with her hands; as they were getting out of the car she saw what looked like a handgun sitting on the dashboard. The Commonwealth presented positive gunshot residue tests taken from Meranda's car's inside soft ceiling and surfaces, arguing that they meant he had fired back at his attackers out through the passenger side window over her head while driving. Meranda was convicted for shooting at each of the three occupants of the other car despite the involvement of another, mystery shooter, whose presence was theorized based on the recovery of another shell casing on the street not far from where the car was abandoned matching the one found in the car's roof rack but not the ones inside the car or from the intersection, which also did not match each other.

**STATEMENT OF THE ISSUES WITH RESPECT TO WHICH MERANDA SEEKS  
DIRECT APPELLATE REVIEW<sup>1</sup>**

- I. The Commonwealth's theory of guilt hinged upon the conjecture that Meranda had turned right after being shot at because he was intending to pursue his attackers in order to shoot back at them. Where the Commonwealth could not prove, and had nothing else upon which to ground an inference, that the gunshot residue and casings in the car were placed there at the time of the crime, did it meet its burden of proof?
- II. Meranda's armed career criminal charge was grounded upon a youthful offender guilty plea to violent crime that the Commonwealth conceded was committed with an air rifle. Is an air rifle a deadly weapon such that his act of juvenile delinquency could properly ground a conviction under G.L. c. 269, § 10G?

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<sup>1</sup> Should direct appellate review be granted, Meranda respectfully requests that this Court also consider the other issues contemplated in his brief: the propriety of his conviction of assault with a deadly weapon as a lesser-included offense of assault to murder under *Commonwealth v. Bright*, 463 Mass. 421 (2012) and its progeny, and the trial court's handling of the issuance of the decision in *Commonwealth v. Guardado*, 491 Mass. 666 (2023) after the close of the evidence but before final instructions.

## ARGUMENT

### **I. The Commonwealth's Argument That Meranda Shot Back At All Was Dependent Upon Conjecture And Could Not Be Proven Beyond A Reasonable Doubt.**

In theorizing shots were fired from Meranda's car without any person witnessing them or anything they hit the Commonwealth's evidence falls far short of what this Court has previously considered sufficient to uphold a conviction. Its entire line of reasoning was dependent on the pure conjecture that Meranda had turned in the same direction as the car with the shooter for nefarious reasons; its circumstantial evidence was otherwise equally explainable with Meranda serving only as victim. Compare *Commonwealth v. Tse*, 495 Mass. 74, 81 (2024) (rejecting argument that defendant's vehicular maneuvering established that he shared shooter's lethal intent because it rested on "a chain of speculative assertions"). See also *Commonwealth v. Gonzalez*, 475 Mass. 396, 407 (2016) (even in combination, circumstantial evidence did not establish beyond a reasonable doubt that defendant participated in crime by driving subject vehicle); *Commonwealth v. MacCormack*, 491 Mass. 848, 860 (2023) ("[W]here the Commonwealth's evidence is entirely circumstantial, it cannot meet its burden if the evidence equally supports inconsistent propositions, as resolution of such a case necessarily requires conjecture or surmise."). If, for example, he had been looking to the right for

traffic as the other car sped past, turning right would have been turning away from the sounds of the shots.

The Commonwealth could not prove that the gunshot residue and casings found in his rental car were not left over from a day at the range, as its experts testified that the residue would remain on inorganic surfaces like the car's interior indefinitely without cleaning and could be spread via secondary transfer. See *Commonwealth v. Morris*, 422 Mass. 254, 257 (1996) (where physical evidence is the only link between defendant and crime they are accused of committing, prosecution must prove beyond a reasonable doubt that evidence was placed there at the time of the crime); *Commonwealth v. French*, 476 Mass. 1023, 1024- 1025 (2017) (while generally in criminal cases Commonwealth does not have to present evidence that excludes every hypothesis of innocence, in cases where physical evidence is only evidence of identity prosecution must couple physical evidence with evidence which reasonably excludes hypothesis that it was left at time other than when crime was being committed). His girlfriend testified that she had not noticed any of the casings found inside - even though, to have been fired in that incident and then found where police saw them on the seat where she had been sitting, they would have had to have landed on her back. There was likewise nothing to ground the Commonwealth's argument that the car's window had been shot out from inside; to the contrary, the match between the shell casing



lodged in the roof and the one on the street strongly suggested Meranda had been shot at again from close range, this time unobserved by cameras, as the family abandoned the car. Despite the inferred presence of this other, mystery shooter, Meranda was convicted of shooting at each of the three occupants of the car from the T intersection; nothing in the Commonwealth's evidence had indicated when, in which direction, or at whom any of the supposed "return shots" had been fired. The position of the cars suggested by the Commonwealth's theory based on the broken window, with the shooter's car to Meranda's car's right, was also unsupported by anything on the traffic cameras or the routes of the two cars plotted on a map. One of the occupants from the other car testified that she did not hear any return shots.

Unlike previous cases where a combination of circumstantial evidence has been used to build a case for a defendant's guilt for a shooting that, while unobserved, unquestionably produced a death or injury, here the combination of circumstantial evidence is being used to presume that any crime occurred at all. Whether someone who *has* a gun can be presumed to have *used* it on any particular occasion is an issue deeply tied into this Court's rapidly evolving jurisprudence on due process in purely circumstantial cases combined with the right to bear arms. It is an issue of such public interest, and so likely to recur, that guidance should be provided directly from this Court to ensure a consistent and

constitutional application of the law between defendants. Because the sufficiency of the evidence issues raised by this case - the degree to which the Commonwealth can ask the jury to infer from circumstantial evidence that a shooting occurred at all, and at whom - are of such public interest that justice requires a final determination by the full Supreme Judicial Court, Meranda therefore respectfully requests direct appellate review.

**II. Whether An Air Rifle Is A Deadly Weapon For Purposes Of § 10G Is A Novel Issue Best Suited To Guidance From This Court.**

Meranda's conviction as an armed career criminal was based upon a youthful offender conviction and is therefore only proper if that conviction involved the use or possession of a deadly weapon. *Commonwealth v. Anderson*, 461 Mass. 616, 631-632 (2012). Meranda's plea was to aggravated rape and armed robbery "to wit, gun," but the gun was not recovered; one month later he was arrested for possession of an air rifle that the victim in the attack recognized. The judge was provided with the materials from the original case as well as the police report supportive of this issue. "[D]eadly weapons are a narrower, more lethal subset of dangerous weapons." *Commonwealth v. Ashford*, 486 Mass. 450, 457 (2020). Deadly weapons only comprise those that are "inherently dangerous to human life." *Commonwealth v. Claudio*, 418 Mass. 103, 108 (1994). See also *Commonwealth v. Drew*, 4 Mass. 391, 396 (1808) (describing deadly weapon as one that would "necessarily," was

"likely to," or would "probably," kill or do great bodily harm). The term is of independent legal significance and while it "clearly includes loaded firearms, certain knives, and explosive devices," it has not previously been applied to air rifles. *Commonwealth v. Rezendes*, 88 Mass. App. Ct. 369, 377-380 (2015).

The judge's adjudication of this issue based on how the air rifle was used in the crime and the use of the generic word "gun" in the indictment, rather than the nature of the weapon itself, was error. *See id.* at 379 (fact finder should base inquiry on the "nature of the weapon itself"); *Commonwealth v. Bastos*, 103 Mass. App. Ct. 376, 380 (2023) (defendant's use of deadly weapon could not be inferred merely from fact of youthful offender adjudication for armed robbery, because the crime refers to being armed with a dangerous weapon). Because the question of whether an air rifle constitutes a deadly weapon for the purposes of G.L. c. 269, § 10G is a novel question of law, the resolution of which is susceptible to broad application, direct appellate review is indicated on this issue as well.

#### **CONCLUSION**

For the foregoing reasons this case presents novel questions of law and of such public interest that justice requires a final determination by the full Supreme Judicial Court, *see* Mass. R. App. P. 11, and Meranda thus respectfully requests direct appellate review.
