The National Institutes of Health (NIH) ranks substance abuse among the top 10 health problems in the United States.


- # 2 = Alcohol
- # 6 = Tobacco
- # 7 = Drug Use Disorders

### Substance abuse clearly is among the most costly health problems in the United States.

- Studies show the annual cost of substance abuse to the Nation to be \$510.8 billion. (Harwood, 2000)
  - ✓ Lost productivity, health care costs, treatment, crime, and the criminal justice system.
  - Alcohol abuse cost the Nation ~ \$191.6 billion.
  - Tobacco use cost the Nation ~ \$167.8 billion.
  - Drug abuse cost the Nation ~ \$151.4 billion.





### **Strategic Prevention Framework**



#### SAMHSA'S Strategic Prevention Framework

Assessment-collect data to determine the population needs, resources, and gaps.

<u>Capacity</u>-mobilize and/or build up resources to meet goals.

Planning-development of a comprehensive plan.

Implementation-carrying out of the plan, using evidence-based prevention programs.

<u>Evaluation</u>-monitoring the implementation, measuring impact, and determining needed improvements.

A lways be mindful of: <u>Sustainability</u>-process of integrating prevention into ongoing operations.


<u>Cultural Competence</u>-interacting with audiences from diverse backgrounds.
