Likely relief for class in 3 weeks or so






## It is not over quite yet

On September 12, the First Circuit reversed and vacated the district court's order staying the termination of the CHNV parole program.

The court did not address the district court's class certification order, which certified a class of all individuals who have received a grant of parole subject to termination. Defendants have briefed a motion to dismiss, and plaintiffs are continuing to litigate the other issues in the case, including the refusal to process the applications.

## Parole Revocation – CBP-1 App

On October 17, Defendants sought a stay due to the lapse in appropriations, and the court denied the stay on October 21

Plaintiffs filed a motion for summary judgment on October 16.

## Birthright Citizenship cases





Myriad of cases filed, but most Judges are ceding to the Barbara v. Trump case where a class was already certified



On July 10, the district court granted provisional class certification and enjoined Defendants from enforcing the EO. The order is here. The class includes all "current and future persons who are born on or after February 20, 2025" who would be denied citizenship under the EO.



Government filed an interlocutory appeal on September 26, 2025

## **Haiti TPS**



On July 15, the court entered judgment for Plaintiffs, setting aside the Secretary's partial vacatur of TPS for Haiti, which Defendants appealed on September 25.

The court also granted Plaintiffs' motion to postpone the effective date of the partial vacatur and denied in part Defendants' motion to dismiss.

Separate litigation pending in D.C. for the refusal to extend TPS for Haitians.

### **Auto-extension of EAD**



# Auto-extension w/filing of EAD application no longer available for:

- (C)(8) Individuals with asylum applications pending
- (C)(9) **Adjustment of status** applicants (green card applicants)
- (A)(3), (A)(5), (A)(7), (A)(8), (A)(10) Refugees, asylees, and individuals granted withholding of removal
- (C)(10), (C)(16), (C)(20), (C)(22), (C)(24), (C)(26), (C)(31) Legalization, registry, NACARA, H-4, and VAWA applicants

10 month wait for EAD renewals.
