CONSTRUCTION SITE FIRE SAFETY TRAINING

The National Association of State Fire Marshals (NASFM) Fire Research and Education Foundation will be presenting Construction Site Fire Safety training at the Department of Fire Services on August 12, 2019 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. This is a comprehensive training program designed to reduce fires in buildings under construction, renovation or demolition.

The Construction Site Fire Safety training program considers a wide spectrum of prevention strategies that can be implemented by construction site stakeholders to prevent catastrophic fires in buildings under construction.

Many of the fires in buildings under construction are very large, sometimes consuming entire blocks, and even spreading beyond the construction site. Not only do these major fires place firefighters and construction personnel at great risk, they jeopardize entire communities.

This course will promote an overall increase in awareness of the need for fire safe behavior on construction sites. We will discuss the need for cultural changes in an attempt to make EVERY person on the job site a dedicated safety advocate.
