- 1. Call to Order: Co-chairperson David Austin called the meeting to order at 12:38 p.m. The Board members in attendance were Maria Pinaud, Marc J. Richards, James N. Smith, Kirk Franklin, and Gregg McBride. Board members Dr. Gail Batchelder, Farooq Siddique, Kathleen Campbell, and Debra Listernick were absent. Ms. Pinaud said that the course <u>Forensic Geochemical and Geophysical Statistical Data</u>
<u>Visualization</u> looked interesting. Mr. Richards commented that he had no issue with the course.
Mr. Austin announced that the course would be approved for six credit hours as requested.

Mr. McBride asked whether the Committee had approved a course similar to <u>Optimization and Monitoring for Bioremediation of Chlorinated Compounds</u> a few months ago. Ms. Williamson responded that this was the first one. Mr. Austin indicated that the Committee approved a number of these sorts of courses and said that it should be approved as proposed.
