This Rate Order on Remand is issued by the Cable Television Division of the Department of Telecommunications and Energy in compliance with the decision issued by the Media Bureau of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") relating to an FCC Form 1240 filed by Cox Com, Inc., d/b/a Cox Communications New England ("Cox"). See CoxCom, Inc., d/b/a/ Cox Communications New England, DA 02-967 (released April 29, 2002). Following an Application for Review filed on May 29, 2002, the full Commission of the FCC determined that the Media Bureau's decision was consistent with Commission and Media Bureau precedent. See CoxCom, Inc., d/b/a Cox Communications New England, FCC 03-72 (released April 3, 2003).

Therefore, the Cable Television Division hereby accepts as reasonable and in compliance with applicable statutes, regulations, and precedent, Cox's FCC Form 1240 as filed on October 23, 2000, and as amended on January 16, 2001, for the Town of Holland. On March 28, 2003, the Cable Television Division approved Cox's subsequent FCC Form 1240 filed on May 1, 2002, and as such, no further action is required.
