After a vehicle has been placed in storage and the owner or his agent requests that the carrier return to stored vehicle to confirm or secure the identification number on the vehicle a fee of \$ 5.00 will be assessed the owner or the person requesting said information.

When carrier is requested to research records of trans portation performed or presumed to have been performed by carrier up to three years a fee of \$ 30.00 per hour will be assessed with a minimum charge of \$ 10.00 being assessed.

When an armed guard is requested or required to be on duty at site of a disabled vehicle due to the contents of the vehicle being of great value also acompanying the disabled vehicle in transit to its final destination a fee of \$ 40.00 per hour per man will be assessed. Time is to be adjusted to the nearest quarter

When the recovery of a disabled vehicle requires the use of special tools but does not require use of the Special Service Van a flat fee for use of said tools will be assessed. Snatch blocks, chock blocks, scotch blocks, oak wood "sections, etc. Use fee: \$ 5.00 per item but not to exceed \$ 50.00.

When addition steel cable is required at the disability site over and beyond the 75 foot on the drum of the wench a fee of \$ 2.00 per linear foot will be assessed. TRANSPORTATION OF REPOSSESSED MOTOR VEHICLES WHEN SAID VEHICLES HAVE BEEN REPOSSED AS PER DUE PROCESS OF LAW.
