

Cybersecurity Improvement Grants for Public Water Systems

*Protect Your Water System from Cyber Threats:
Apply for up to \$50,000 in funding*

Program Overview

The **Massachusetts Clean Water Trust**, in partnership with the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection Drinking Water Program (**MassDEP DWP**), is offering grants funds of up to **\$50,000** to Public Water Systems (PWSs) with cybersecurity risks in their operational technology (OT) equipment.

Eligibility

- PWS serving **fewer than 10,000 people**, OR
- Located in a **Disadvantaged Community**
- PWS must have OT equipment with cybersecurity risks
- PWS must have completed a cybersecurity assessment within the last two years

Eligible Projects

- Upgrading, replacing, or removing unsupported and end-of-life hardware, software, and operating systems
- Cybersecurity training and incident response planning
- Network segmentation and remote access security
- Encryption implementation
- Developing and updating an emergency response plan/cybersecurity incident response plan

Program Goals

Support PWSs in improving their cybersecurity defense, mitigating the risks of cyber-attacks, and enhancing resiliency and compliance.

Application Timeline

Applications are accepted and reviewed on a first-come, first-served basis until all funds are expended.
