Anime streaming giant Crunchyroll says hacker stole data related to customer service tickets

The popular anime streaming platform Crunchyroll confirmed that a batch of customer information that was stolen through a third-party customer service vendor and leaked online is legitimate.



FBI warns of Russian, Iranian cyber activity involving messaging platforms

The FBI issued warnings about separate Russian and Iranian cyber campaigns involving social media messaging platforms like Signal and Telegram.

FCC bans foreign-made routers from US market over 'unacceptable risk'
