Passwords are your first line of defense against cyber attacks

Use passwords with both upper and lowercase letters, numbers, and symbols.

Always lock your screen if you are away from the computer.

Change your password frequently but not in a predictable manner.

Use two-factor authentications.

Report any suspicious activity immediately.



XShare your password with anyone.

XLet your devices remember your password.

XUse the same password for multiple accounts.

XUse common or easily guessable passwords, like simple keyboard patterns.

XUse your password on an unsecured network.
