


Bedrooms

All kids have their own rooms and you can have your own stuff and your own toys in it.








Three Rivers School

School happens Monday - Friday 8:15-2:15. We have three classrooms just downstairs from the bedrooms.






Living Room






Sensory Room

We have our own cook. We eat all of our meals here. We sometimes do activities or cooking here too.






We play in here and do games. We have basketball and a climbing wall.


Art Room




Family Support



just for families at the program and sometimes at home.


Family Days

Directions to Three Rivers Program—Residential/School Building

- 91 south to exit 6.
- Take the first left at bottom of exit onto Union St.
- Turn right at 3rd light onto Main Street.
- Take the first left onto Mulberry Street.
- When you get to One Way signs, turn left onto Ridgewood Terrace.
- First Driveway on left leads to our parking area.
- Park and come around front to ring the doorbell.
- The door is marked 32.

For meetings at 32 Ridgewood Place (Directions to the Administration building, therapy offices and conference room)



- Park as close as you can to this house which is directly across from where the road forks.
- Building has a brown porch and is marked 26 Ridgewood Terrace.
- Go up and ring the bell.
- The door is marked 32.
