DECISION

MAZVAR INC. D/B/A GREENRIDGE VARIETY CONVENIENCE
1086 SOUTH STREET
DALTON, MA 01226

Mazvar Inc. d/b/a Greenridge Variety Convenience (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, October 2, 2018, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Kujawski's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Kujawski's Compliance Check Field Report;
 2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
 3. Photograph of Underage Operative.

The Commission took Administrative Notice of the Licensee's record.

FACTS


1. On Wednesday, August 1, 2018, at approximately 6:15 p.m., Investigators Di Cicco and Kujawski ("Investigators") investigated the business of Mazvar Inc. d/b/a Greenridge Variety Convenience.
2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a 6-pack of Bud Light beer, for six dollars and twenty-nine cents (\$6.29). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. As the Licensee has had no prior violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
