DECISION

BLETA-COTTI, INC. D/B/A I PAZZI
50 MAPLE STREET

Bleta-Cotti, Inc. d/b/a I Pazzi¹ (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("Commission" or "ABCC") held a hearing on Tuesday, November 5, 2019, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)-Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Di Cicco's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Di Cicco's Compliance Check Field Report;
2. Licensee Stipulation of Fact;
3. Copy of License Transfer Approval, 4/2/2009;
4. Copy of New License Approval for All-Alcohol, 9/19/2011.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FACTS

1. On Wednesday, July 31, 2019, at approximately 6:39 p.m., Investigators Bolcome and Di Cicco ("Investigators") conducted an investigation of the business operation of Bleta-Cotti, Inc. d/b/a I Pazzi.
2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, an Amstel Light beer. The underage operative was not asked for identification.

¹ Due to a scrivener's error, the Licensee was incorrectly identified in the Compliance Check Field Report and the Commission's Hearing Notice as Bella Cotti, Inc. The correct corporate name is Bleta-Cotti, Inc.

3. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 12 since 2009 with no prior violations.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. The Commission issues a **WARNING**.


