DECISION

Thai Taste Too, Inc. dba Thai Taste Too

Thai Taste Too, Inc. dba Thai Taste Too (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, September 20, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Jamie Binienda's Compliance Check Field Report.


FACTS

1. On, July 25, 2011 at approximately 5:32 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Thai Taste Too, Inc. dba Thai Taste Too.
2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, possessed a Bud Light bottle. The underage operative was not asked for identification.
3. Administrative review of the file reveals that the licensee has no prior violations in ten (10) years of ownership.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission **suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**
