If accepted, you may pay a fine using the enclosed form. All checks must be certified and accompanied by the enclosed form, which must be signed by a Massachusetts Licensed Accountant.

You are advised that you have the right to appeal this decision under M.G.L. c. 30A to Superior Court within thirty (30) days upon receipt of this notice.

Dartmouth Wasabi, Inc. dba Wasabi Japanese Restaurant (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for four (4) days of which two (2) days will be served and two (2) days held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.

By decision dated June11, 2010, the Commission had previously ordered a three (3) day license suspension but had held the suspension in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations occurred. Based on the violation found above, the licensee violated the conditions of that three (3) day license suspension being held in abeyance. The Commission hereby orders that suspension to be served on and after the 2 day suspension. The licensee will serve a total of 5 days.
