DECISION OF THE FULL COMMISSION

On January 11, 2018 Hearing Officer Betty Waxman issued a decision in favor of the Complainant, Peter Dateo, in the above-entitled matter. The parties were duly notified of the decision and Respondent filed a Notice of Appeal on February 1, 2018.


The Commission's Rules of Procedure at 804 C.M.R. 1.23(1)(a) require that, in addition to a Notice of Appeal, an aggrieved party must file a Petition for Review within 30 days of receipt of the decision of the hearing officer, setting forth:


1. Facts showing the appellant to be aggrieved;
2. All matters alleged to have been erroneously decided;
3. All other matters on which the appellant relies and;


4. The relief to which the appellant believes it is entitled, which relief may be requested in the alternative.

Respondent has not filed a Petition for Review as required by 804 C.M.R 1.23. As a result of this failure to perfect its appeal in accordance with Commission regulations, Respondent's appeal is hereby dismissed and the Order of the Hearing Officer in favor of Complainant Peter M. Dateo stands.
