Terms Certification Uses What You May See

<u>Amendment</u> <u>Expansion</u>

An Expansion is an Amendment Application. A contractor may add or delete a category of work, adjust their single project limit or aggregate work limit, add Supplier Diversity Certification or change company legal name. This term is commonly used in online training.

Category of Work

Commodity Code

Commodity Codes are various classes of work in the building construction industry the contractor has experience and competence to perform. When asked to add Commodity Code this means to add/select your category of work. This term is commonly used in online training.

<u>Evaluation</u> <u>Reference</u>

A Reference is an evaluation used to rate a contractor on a single building project according to criteria established for assessing the performance on the project. This term is commonly used in online training.
