Skaters must bring their own helmets and be able to get on and off the ice, in and out of equipment, and skate independently or with the assistance of accompanying staff. Accessible Yurt Camping: Reserve now for summer 2019! Stay in an accessible DCR yurt at Shawme-Crowell State Forest in Sandwich, Myles Standish State Forest in Carver, or Nickerson State Park in Brewster.

Small yurts sleep up to 4 people, while large yurts sleep up to 6 people. Yurts range in price from \$45–\$70 per night.
