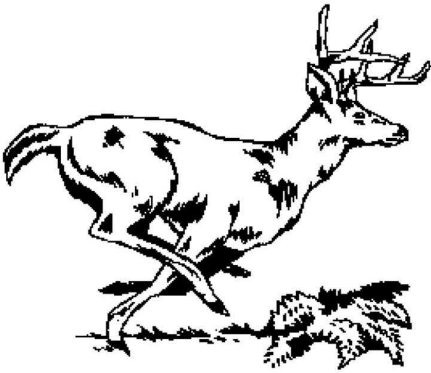

- IMPORTANT REMINDER:
- Please check-out by 4PM.
 - Access is through the east entrance. No parking on Rt 9.
 - When parking, please pull off road.
 - Webster Rd will be open for driving, weather and conditions permitting.
 - Refer to the Quabbin hunt website for number of deer permitted to be harvested in a given year. You may harvest a second deer with the appropriate permits before checking in the first deer.
 - Please note locations and sex of any moose seen for DWSP's moose survey.
 - Hunting in Quabbin Park is permitted during scheduled two-day hunts with a special access permit; hunters submit an application and are selected through a lottery.
 - A Quabbin two-week Hunt Access permit will not get you access to any two-day controlled hunts.



- IF YOU KILL A DEER
- Fill out the ear tag for the appropriate permit and attach to the deer.
 - Antlerless – Quabbin Park Antlerless Permit
 - Antlered – Hunting License
 - Make certain the ear tag is securely attached so it will not fall off while moving the deer.
 - Take your deer to the Quabbin Deer Check Station.
